### **FELLOWSHIP - OUTREACH:            *Preschool Liaison***

One of the goals of this program is to “***bridge the gap***” by reaching out to non-member preschool mothers to help build relationships with church members. One positive way to reach this goal is by inviting mothers to participate in spiritual or fellowship events hosted by the church or the *Women on a Mission*.

Other goals of this program are to gain parents confidence in our school and church staff members, as well as offer support and encouragement in family illnesses, needs, etc.

#### **This position’s responsibility includes:**

- Organize preschool brunches/coffee, inviting each preschool / kindergarten class.
  - These are held on the first day of school, or before.
  - Send out invitations to encourage other church and school members to attend.
  - Reach out to fathers as well as mothers, if situation applies.
  - Several times a year, make announcements of the name of the Preschool Liaison, in the school Cougar News.
  
- Organize other functions throughout the school year for the preschool parents that may also involve church members.
  - Communication with the *church* Fellowship and Outreach Chairmen may be helpful.
  
- Prepare a brief written report of scheduled events, and forward to the *Women on a Mission Fellowship Outreach Coordinator*. This will be reviewed at the women’s next monthly board meeting.
  - To ensure that no dates conflict, all event dates should be submitted to the pastor, school principal and church secretary for approval.
  - Please inform the pastor, church secretary, school principal of all confirmed events scheduled. They will need to be posted on the master church schedule and announcements prepared.
