FELLOWSHIP - OUTREACH: *School Liaison*

One of the goals of this program is to “**bridge the gap**” by reaching out to non-member school mothers to help build relationships with church members. One positive way to reach this goal is by inviting mothers to participate in spiritual or fellowship events hosted by the church or the *Women on a Mission*.

Other goals of this program are to gain parents confidence in our school and church staff members, as well as offer support and encouragement in family illnesses, needs, etc.

This position’s responsibility includes:

- Work with preschool liaison, church pastor and church members, principal, and *Women on a Mission*, for events that be appropriate or created to invite upper grade school moms to. Communication with the church Fellowship and Outreach Chairmen may also be helpful.
- Several times a year, make announcements of the name of the School Liaison, in the school Cougar News.
- Prepare a brief written report or outline of scheduled events, and forward to the *Women on a Mission Fellowship Outreach Coordinator*. This will be reviewed at the next *Women on a Mission* monthly board meeting.
 - To ensure that no dates conflict, all event dates should be submitted to the school principal and church secretary for approval.
 - Please inform the pastor, church secretary, school principal of all confirmed events scheduled. They will need to be posted on the master church schedule and announcements prepared.
