SERVICE - MEMBER: *Church /Kitchen Special Cleaning*

Special cleanings of the church are performed twice a year, before Thanksgiving and Easter. They include cleaning areas in the church sanctuary that are not cleaned weekly. A thorough cleaning of the kitchen should be done before the start of school and basic upkeep cleaning as needed.

Church:

1. Balcony lights dusted for cobwebs
2. Balcony railing dusted
3. Ceiling lights in back of church cleaned
4. Hanging ceiling lights dusted for cobwebs
5. Mounted speakers vacuumed
6. Pews seats vacuumed and spot cleaned
7. Pews washed with Murphy's Oil Soap and polished with Dosz It or Guardsmen Furniture polish.
8. Planking dusted as far as one can reach
9. Windows washed, inside and out

Kitchen:

1. Clean cupboards, inside and out
2. Discard unwanted items.
3. Rearrange supplies, food if needed.
4. Clean refrigerator and stove as needed.

This position's responsibility includes:

- Select a day and time that will be convenient for those who have already confirmed interest in serving this duty.
- Put a notice in the church newsletter and bulletin asking for volunteers to help.
- If the cleaning is scheduled in the morning, you may wish to organize a prepared lunch for the women helping.
- See that necessary equipment and materials are available or ask that others bring their own vacuum, bucket, rags, etc.
- Get as much cleaned as you can, sometimes amount of help will dictate what can be done.
- Thank all those who have helped carry out this immense duty.
